

Multiplication Wheel Template

1. Copy onto cardstock.
2. Cut out circle, including the circle in the center.
3. Laminate.
4. Students place Multiplication Wheel Template on a white board / slate board.
5. Students write a factor in the center of the wheel (ie: x5, x3, x8, etc...) and then multiply the number in the center of the wheel to each of the numbers in the wheel.
6. Students write the products on the outside of the wheel.
7. Students erase their work, select a different factor and practice some more!
